

Roofing Material Guidelines

In order to preserve the aesthetic and homogenous appearance of our Homestead in the Willows neighborhood, the Board Members with the assistance of the Architectural Control Committee has set forth a generic guideline for cedar shake alternative roofing materials. The following cedar shake alternatives have thus far been judged by the Homestead in the Willows Board and ACC to have an appearance similar to a cedar shake in thickness, texture, profile and with colors of medium/dark brown or medium/dark gray:

Due to Senate Bill 5-100, Asphalt Tri-cut Laminate has been approved by ACC as follows:

You must submit an "Application for Architectural Change" and obtain HOA ACC approval prior to replacing your roof. You may be planning to utilize a product that is already listed above and already judged by the Homestead in the Willows Board & HOA ACC to have an appearance similar to a cedar shake in thickness, texture, profile and in the colors of medium/dark brown or medium/dark gray. However, our Homestead in the Willows covenants require that you first complete an application and obtain approval from the HOA Architectural Control committee.

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
